ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NEWBURY PARK LITTLE LEAGUE

The name of this corporation is: FIRST:

NEWBURY PARK LITTLE LEAGUE

That the specific and primary purpose for SECOND: which this corporation is formed is:

To implant firmly in the boys of the (a) community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage, and reverence, so that they may be well adjusted, stronger and happier boys and will grow to be good, clean, healthy, and trustworthy men.

That the general purposes and powers are:

- To take charge of and manage all of the (d) property of said corporation and the affairs thereof.
- This corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of California, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended, provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.
- To engage in such activities as the (đ) membership may from time to time direct, provided, however, that such activities may not contravene the foregoing purposes, and provided further that such activities are not for the benefit of any individual or individuals, but are to operate and perpetuate the corporation.
- (e) To purchase, lease, hold, sell, develop, mortgage, convey or otherwise acquire or dispose of real and personal property only as the same is necessary or proper for carrying out the purposes of this corporation and to erect such ap-

EIGHTH: The Constitution and By-Laws of the corporation may provide for more than one class of membership and may define the rights and privileges of members of each class so established, and may provide for a differentiation of voting rights as between different classes of membership.

NINTH: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private persons. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

If this corporation holds any assets in trust, or the corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, upon petition therefor by the Attorney

General, or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.
